The Kids & I Resource Center is a place for parents and caregivers to go with their young children and interact with others from the community within a fun and safe environment. Children from birth to the completion of senior kindergarten (last day of school in June) who are supervised by an adult may attend Kids & I

Goals

- To provide an informal, accessible location where parents and caregivers can meet with their children
- To provide preschool children with a stimulating environment with crafts, sensory play, dramatic play, block building, books, puppets and puzzles

Toy Library Membership

The Kids & I Resource Centre Library offers a variety of toys, puzzles, popular children's videos, puppets, games and books for young children. The library also offers a selection of resource books filled with great ideas on parenting, craft ideas, circle time songs and stories.

The yearly fee is \$25.00 per family, and \$35.00 per year for daycares and nursery school programs.

Toys are signed out for a two week period.
